- Financial Policy Requirements

- The total cost of program must be paid at the time of enrollment into a program.
- I-20 Documents will be issued upon receipt of all fees paid to Antelope Valley Christian School.
- Applications and returning registrations will be accepted on a space available basis.
- Confirmation of intent to attend the Fall Semester of the 2010-2011 School Year must be made by July 30, 2010. After July 30, 2010, all costs are non-refundable even if a student is expelled or withdraws for any reason.

- Refund Policy

- If a student is not granted a visa, a refund will be given of all but \$750.00 of the costs.
- The refund will be issued with two weeks, upon receipt of the Official Visa Denial form and return of the original I-20.
- I-20 is not required for the American Cultural Experience (ACE) Camp, U.S. citizens, or green card holders.
